*Dear Reader:*

*In fact, many people choose to live in North Fulton solely for the quality of our schools. While the Chamber works hard to position itself in attracting and retaining businesses, we understand one of the most important factors an industry considers before relocating is the value of education we can offer to its employees' families.*

*The primary goal of the Greater North Fulton Chamber of Commerce's Education Committee is to strengthen the link between our schools and the business community. Our first edition of the Education Resource Manual is intended to increase both the number of partnerships between businesses and schools as well as the quality of those relationships.*

*When exploring the barriers to forming meaningful interactions between schools and businesses, two recurring themes arose. Similarly, we have conducted a survey of Chamber members who are interested in forming new partnerships with local schools. Those businesses are listed in the Manual along with the appropriate contact information and a list of resources they have to contribute to a partnership.*

*I would be remiss in not expressing my appreciation to the people whose hard work is reflected in this Manual becoming reality.
