



## Ready to Find Your Next Intern?

What is an Internship? An internship is an opportunity offered by an employer to a student, seeking to gain authentic work experience in their field of study by applying knowledge and skills acquired during their academic study. Typically interns will work with an organization for 3-6 months and can be a paid or non-paid experience.

What is a Registered Apprenticeship? A Registered Apprenticeship is a program that works with the U.S. Department of Labor to connect students looking to learn a new skill while working with an organization. Typically, an apprentice will work with the organization from a minimum of 1 year to 4 years.

## To meet CareerLink company standards for intern employment, an employer must have:

- 1) At least 2 employees
- 2) A Company website
- 3) A physical non-residential property address
- 4) Commercial liability insurance
- 5) Reasonable ratings with the Better Business Bureau
- 6) Provide a mentor/professional to work directly with the student in their field of study
